# **Comfort Blue Lagoon Tour**

Rest and rejuvenate at the Blue Lagoon, a geothermal spa filled with healing mineral-infused warm waters. The mineral salts, silica and blue-green algae of the Blue Lagoon are used within the spa to provide healing and relaxation services. Enjoy Comfort Level entrance with towel rental, a drink and an algae mask.

## Golden Circle Classic Tour

Take the Golden Circle route by starting with Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site for its beautiful landscape. From there, head to the breathtaking Gullfoss Waterfall, with geysir hot springs nearby. Continue to Laugarvatn and Apavatn Lakes before ending at the historic Skalholt Church, the religious center of Iceland for over seven centuries.

## Greater Area Reykjavik Sightseeing Tour

The Hallgrimskirkja Church, with an innovative architectural design, will also be visited on your tour, along with a walk through the old town center.

# Inside the Glacier - Waterfalls, Hot Springs, and Langjokull Ice Cave Tour

Ride an 8-wheel glacier truck through the west Highlands of Iceland to man-made ice tunnels that take you into the ice cave of Langjokull Glacier. See the ice change colors as you explore, then visit the Deildartunguhver Thermal Spring. Be careful not to stand stand too close - water temperatures reach over 200 degrees fahrenheit! Next, see the several falls of Barnafossar before heading back to Reykjavik.

## Taste the Saga Brewery Tour

Learn the history of brewing in Iceland, with a visit to Olgerdin Brewery in Reykjavik. Taste the substitute drink Icelanders used during prohibition and a shot of the local Brennivin, an unsweetened schnapps nicknamed 'Black Death'. If this drink is too adventurous for you, enjoy one of the many other beverages you'll taste on this tour.

## Walk through Ice and Fire Tour

Start with a walk around the geothermal area of Hengill Volcano, a major source of energy for Southern Iceland. Afterwards, relax in a naturally warm stream of Reykjadalur Valley. Then, drive by Iceland's fourth largest glacier, Myrdalsjokull. The last stop will be Solheimajokull Glacier, where you'll walk on the beautiful glacial fields.

#### Whale Watching from Reykjavik Tour
