St. Mark's Cathedral & Cloister of St. Apollonia

Your tour starts seated in the center of the cathedral, where you will learn of the thousand-year-long history of the cathedral. In addition to the guided tour to St. Mark's Basilica, you will get access to the oldest surviving Cloister of St. Apollonia and to the Marciano Lapidary. The Lapidary is located inside the Cloister, and it presents a remarkable collection of decorative fragments that used to beautify St. Mark's Church.
